Creating A CoCoRaHS Condition Monitoring Account

In order to participate in CoCoRaHS Condition Monitoring, one must first create a CoCoRaHS account.

- 1. Navigate to www.cocorahs.org
- 2. Click "Join CoCoRaHS" on the left-hand side of the webpage
- 3. Select the country in which you will be taking observations. At this point, CoCoRaHS is available in the United States, Canada, and the Bahamas
- 4. Fill out the top half of the application form. It should look like this: For your station address, please use the address of the place you plan to monitor. This address will be used to pinpoint your report on the CoCoRaHS Condition Monitoring map.

- 5. CoCoRaHS is primarily a rainfall reporting network, so some of the questions on the bottom half of the application may look strange. Not to worry. **You do not need to purchase a gauge to participate in Condition Monitoring.** Fill out the rest of the form following these steps:
 - I. If you do not have a gauge, select "I will need to obtain this type of gauge."
 - II. Under "Rain gauge will be emptied daily at:" select any time. It does not matter.
 - III. Check the box acknowledging that a 4" manual rain gauge is required for participation in CoCoRaHS. Again, having a rain gauge is NOT a requirement for taking Condition Monitoring reports.
