- 1. Login to the CoCoRaHS website. If you do not have an account, see login instructions
- 2. Select "Condition Monitoring Report" in the "Enter My New Reports" section on the left-hand side of the webpage.



For steps 3-7 refer to image below:

- 3. Select your report date. The form will default to the current date, but you may back date reports
- 4. Select the category in the Condition Scale Bar that best reflects your observed conditions
- 5. Comments: This is the most important part! Comments are what give Condition Monitoring reports life. Describe any ways in which the conditions you are seeing differ from what you would expect. Be creative.

Useful things to include in your comments:

- i. Soil temperature and moisture conditions: (e.g. dry, muddy, frozen)
- ii. Tree damage (especially if caused by beetles)
- iii. Leaf budding (if spring), leave color/drop (if fall)
- iv. Pond/creek/stream level (if applicable at your observation site)
- v. If your station is a wildfire burn scar, please note any signs of recovery
- 6. Note sectors that have been adversely impacted by dry/wet conditions under "Report Categories"
- 7. Click "Submit Data"
